



CONTEST RULES

1. Posters must measure 11 X 14 inches. Artwork MUST be INDIVIDUAL... *NO GROUP PROJECTS*.. and can be either *horizontal* or *vertical* on the page.
2. Each poster must have the enclosed entry form attached to the back of the poster. (A copy ready entry form can be printed off WWW.NJPIES.ORG)
3. Each poster must include the theme words:

CHILDREN ACT FAST... SO DO POISONS

4. Posters should be hand drawn with crayon, watercolor, ink or markers and only the slogan may be written on the poster. (Encourage artists to interpret their ideas in pictures, not words).
5. All entries should be two dimensional. No collages.
6. Please provide us with the total number of students participating in your school. Upon receipt of your posters, you will receive certificates to distribute to all of the students who participated in the contest.
7. During Poison Prevention Week, winning posters will be displayed at NJPIES.
8. Winners' information will be released to the media for recognition.
9. *Parents:* In the event that your child should be a winner, please be aware that NJPIES will be requesting a valid social security number from you. Your child's SSN# is needed in order for your child to receive his/her Federal Savings Bond.

Posters will be judged and winners will be notified in February. Prizes will be awarded at a special ceremony to be determined at a later date. Winners will be notified by letter.
