DO

DO remain calm.
The NJ Poison Control
Center will help you.



DO NOT drink milk or
water. Call the NJ
Poison Control Center.

DO call
the NJ Poison
Control Center
1-800-222-1222



DO NOT take (or give)
syrup of ipecac. **Do Not**
make a person vomit
unless you are told to
do so by the NJ Poison
Control Center
or your doctor.



DO *rinse* the person's
eyes. Use a gentle
stream of warm water
and pour in the eyes.



DO NOT follow first
aid directions on the
bottle. Many are
wrong. Call the NJ
Poison Control Center
for medical advice.



DO *wash* the person's
skin. Use warm water
and mild soap.



DO NOT rush to the
hospital emergency
room. The NJ Poison
Control Center will
make transportation
arrangements if
necessary.
